

2018 Gewurztraminer Elkton OR AVA

Our 2018 gewurztraminer was sourced from two sites within the Elkton Oregon AVA, both planted in 1983, Bradley Vineyard and Anindor Vineyard. The vineyards have similar soils born of alluvial Umpqua River deposits. Our growing season in coastal Elkton is long and temperate with typically little rainfall between April and October. 2018 was a good year for grapes here, not too hot, no rain during the ripening season and a very favorable fall for the fruit.

This wine is a beautiful pale golden straw color. The fruit aromas begin with a candied grapefruit note, followed by interesting citrus, tangerine, lychee, and with savory spices of cardamom and a touch of fennel. The entry of this wine is full and plush. The fruit flavors begin to reveal some green apple notes. The acidity is crisp and pleasant, complimented by the touch of sweetness. This full bodied wine lingers upon your palate.
