

2021 Pinot Gris Elkton OR AVA

In 2021 all of our pinot gris came from two Elkton Oregon AVA vineyards. Elk Valley Vineyard is on a west facing slope 2 miles south east of our winery. Our other source that we have worked with for a number of years is the Anindor
Vineyard, on a west facing bench 3 miles east of our winery in Elkton. The soils of both are born of the Umpqua River, windblown river sediments, called appropriately windygap. 2021 was a welcoming vintage that returned to a semblance of normal, except for rainfall, at least for what we have known in our 20th Anniversary year here in Elkton.
Fruit set was good. The flowering season and growing season progressed on pace. We did have a couple of heat spikes, but our deep soils kept the canopies in good shape. Grapes from both vineyards came in on September 15 and were combined in tank after pressing and settling.

The wine is a very pale straw color with some golden highlights. The aromas explode from the glass, a fragrant summer mix of jasmine, hydrangea and roses, with a touch of fresh mown hay. Flavors abound with crisp green apple, ripe pear, tropical mango, and finishes with a creamy lemon meringue. The wine is full and supple in the mouth and well balanced, with a cleansing acidy, lingering aftertaste.

All seafood and shellfish preparations would be a lovely compliment to this wine, as well as soft, pungent cheeses.
